The honoured guest, Maria Teresa de Filippis, first woman to have taken part in the Formula 1 World Championship, on Maserati, will chair the jury of the Concours d'Elegance and many other activities during the weekend.

Other distinguished guests, Anneliese Abarth, who decided to come back after the last year success and also, as already mentioned, Andrea Zagato, who once again will honour Belgium of his presence. With all these famous names on their program, you will understand that the Spaltalia organizers have concentrated their efforts in making this year event an international one.
